
HEALTH SCIENCES COMING TO ORCHARD RIDGE IN 2027

- Health Sciences & Nursing programs are planned to be moved from the Highland and Southfield campuses.
- Orchard Ridge campus buildings will be renovated into state-of-the-art learning spaces.
- The Highland Lakes campus is planned to close in 2027 following the renovation.

AUBURN HILLS CREST EXPANSION

- OCC's Public Services' CREST facility is expanding to meet ongoing high-demand for emergency services training.
- Expansion includes an indoor gun range and indoor tactical village to simulate scenarios.

- Construction of a new driving pad has an expected completion in Fall 2026.

Proposed Athletics Complex at Orchard Ridge



Proposed is a public-private partnership to develop a new athletics complex to include:

- ❖ A new field house built and operated by OCC
- ❖ A hockey arena built and operated by LCAAAA, Little Caesars AAA Hockey Club

The new sports facilities are tentatively projected to open in 2028.
